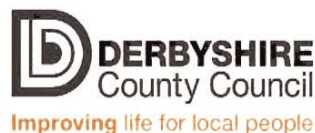
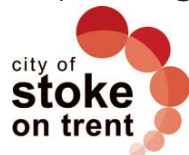

What is Pass Plus?

Pass Plus is a course that you can take once you have passed your driving test. It consists of 6 hours of practical sessions and you can usually take these with any Driving Instructor; the cost can range between £120 and £180.

The purpose of Pass Plus is to provide extra training that will make you a safer driver. As a reward for taking this course, many insurance companies will give you a discount off your premium.

What is Pass Plus Extra?

Pass Plus Extra is a Council led scheme where you have to attend an interactive two hour workshop to receive a discount on the cost of the Pass Plus course. With the subsidy **you only pay £60.**

The workshops are held regularly in Stafford, Stoke-on-Trent, Leek, Codsall, Newcastle, Lichfield, Burton-on-Trent and Swadlincote. Practical sessions can only be taken with one of our registered instructors.

How Do I Apply?

Complete the application form and return to the address below. Confirmation will be sent to you, together with a reference number, a list of registered instructors and instructions on how to book your workshop, which must be completed before your practical sessions.
